manufactured, marketed and/or sold by Defendants, that contain one or more Lithium Ion Battery Cells manufactured by Defendants or their alleged co-conspirators. Lithium Ion Battery Products include, but are not limited to, notebook computers, cellular(mobile)phones, digital cameras, camcorders and power tools and replacement batteries for these products.
